Job Description	<p>Job purpose A Clinician is fully licensed mental health provider who offers strengths-based support for persons living with moderate to severe mental health difficulties and disorders. They are responsible for meeting with clients, facilitating support groups, communicating with interdisciplinary team, guiding clients in the referral process, network expansion and serving as a representative for training events and programs administered or attended by the HHCI. This person will have experience in Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (CBT) and Dialectic Behavioral Therapy (DBT) and will participate in both Clinical programs at HHCI. Duties and responsibilities Clinical Services • Maintain an active license (LPC, LCSW, LPA, LMFT or similar) • Carry a clinical case load of up to 20 clients (combination of CBT and DBT clients) • Facilitate 1-2 support groups • Provide skilled crisis intervention services and family consulting • Timely documentation for all client services • Provide screenings/intake assessments for HHCI services • Weekly participation in consultation groups • Effectively communicate with interdisciplinary team across all clinical programs: CBT- Based Coaching, DBT, Telepsychiatry and Case Management Network Expansion • Weekly research for new community resources through in person interviews, emails, phone calls • Occasional travel across Houston and surrounding areas for network expansion • Actively assist clients and members in the community in finding resources for professional care and treatment Administrative Duties • Develop and contribute material for websites and blog • May conduct educational presentations for community through Lunch & Learn or CEUs at center • Obtain proper documentation for all client encounters • Stay up to date on all new trainings and research • Computer knowledge and adaptable to online documentation systems Working conditions Position is Monday thru Friday 9/80 with the possibility of working one evening shift per week to facilitate support group. Position may require occasional travel throughout the city of Houston and surrounding areas as part of networking and outreach duties. Clinical work will include working with a wide spectrum of individuals struggling with moderate to severe mental health difficulties. Physical requirements Must be able to lift 50 lbs.</p>

Qualifications	<p>Applicants for the position must have a master's degree in psychology, counseling or social work and at least one year of experience in a clinical setting. Preferred applicants will possess licensure (LPC, LMSW, LCSW, LMFT, or LCDC). Applicants will have experience with both CBT and DBT modalities. Preferred applicants will have experience facilitating groups, conducting psychosocial interviews, connecting clients with referrals in the community, crisis intervention, and providing CBT and DBT services. Applicants that are license eligible may be considered. Proficiency in Spanish is preferred but not required. Applicants must possess technical, clerical, critical thinking and interpersonal skills relevant to total client care in order to safely and efficiently treat clients. Applicant must have the ability to prioritize work with minimal supervision, in order to independently carry out duties.</p>
